

## Chris Lieberman

Chris Lieberman joined Con Edison's Operations Emergency Management as a Project Specialist in 2012 and is assigned as the embedded employee in Steam Operations. His duties also include being involved in several department programs and initiatives including, but not limited to, the Con Edison Biological Chemical Weapon Response Team (CEBCWRT).
